## Talks for Change

### How do I book this?

You can use our simple booking form [here](#) and you will hear back within 2-3 days from our team at For Jimmy with more information. They will work with you to find the best date and time, to arrange all logistics, and to make sure that the talk meets the specific needs of your school.

### What happens on the day?

Barry & Margaret (Jimmy's parents) or Danny Mizen (Jimmy's brother) usually speak to one or two year groups for up to 45 minutes, with additional time for questions, either within the same setting if students are willing to speak up in a large group, or separately with each tutor group.

### What is the talk about?

After a short video, the family share what Jimmy was like as a young person, and what he meant to them as a family.

They then walk through what happened on the day that he was killed, and how they each experienced this individually.

There are then three key questions to explore:

- ▶ **What did the family do in response?**  
Themes of forgiveness and justice
- ▶ **Why did it happen in the first place?**  
Themes of value and self-worth, bullying, anger and consequences of actions
- ▶ **What can we each do to prevent this happening in the future?**  
Themes of individual responsibility and community cohesion

## What happens afterwards?

First off, we love to hear feedback from teachers and students, and we will be in touch with some simple feedback forms.
